

## ALGONQUIN AND LAKESHORE CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD

TAKE NOTICE that the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board passed the 2017 Education Development Charges By-Law (City of Kingston) on the $10^{\text {th }}$ day of October, 2017, as By-Law no. 2017-10-01.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal the said by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board under section 257.65 of the Education Act by filing with the Secretary of the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board on or before the $20^{\text {th }}$ day of November, 2017, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons supporting the objection.

The said by-law comes into force on October 15, 2017. The schedule of education development charges imposed by the by-law is as follows:

Charge on residential development: $\$ 254.00$ per dwelling unit
The education development charges are imposed on all residential development of lands in the City of Kingston. Accordingly, a key map showing the location of the lands subject to the said by-law is not provided as part of this notice.

A complete copy of the 2017 Education Development Charges By-Law (City of Kingston) is available for examination in the offices of the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board, located at 151 Dairy Avenue, Napanee, Ontario, K7R 4B2, during regular office hours.

Notice of a proposed by-law amending the 2017 Education Development Charges By-Law (City of Kingston) or the passage of such an amending by-law is not required to be given to any person or organization, other than to certain clerks of municipalities or secretaries of school boards, unless the person or organization gives the Secretary of the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board a written request for notice of any amendments to the 2017 Education Development Charges By-Law (City of Kingston), and has provided a return address.
