IMPORTANT-Updated Covid Screener

Parents have the responsibility to self-screen students for symptoms of COVID-19, common cold, influenza and any other respiratory illness <u>each day</u> prior to arriving at school. Please see attached the <u>updated</u> Self-Assessment Tool for COVID-19.

To ensure that our school remains open it will take all of us doing our part. Therefore it is important that families are transparent about the reasons for their child(ren) being absent from school. We understand how difficult it is on families to adhere to the Public Health guidelines but it is the only way to protect our school community. No one can say with certainty that they have not been exposed to Covid, the only decisive action is to be tested. We appreciate your support as we know that these are very challenging times.

Masks - Please send extra clean masks with your child each day. They tend to get wet when worn outside at recess. Also, thank you for modelling safety for our students by also wearing masks when on school property.

Kindergarten Registration - Registration is occurring for September, 2021. If you have a child that will be attending Junior Kindergarten, please preregister by going to our website (www.alcdsb.on.ca/school/cart). To be eligible for Junior Kindergarten students must turn 4 years of age by December 31, 2021. Please provide your child's birth certificate, baptismal certificate, immunization record and proof of residency. Please call the school if you have questions.



1. Does your child have any of the following symptoms (new or worsening)?st



- any of the symptoms above (even if only 1 symptom is present):
- Child must stay home and isolate from others. Child and all household contacts must isolate until the child receives a negative COVID-19 test result or an alternate diagnosis from a health care provider .
- If testing is recommended but does not occur, child must isolate for 10 days from symptom onset. Household contacts must isolate for 14 days following last contact with child. •
- S If the symptomatic individual cannot isolate from the rest of the household, ALL household members must quarantine for 14 days, starting from the end of the symptomatic individual' isolation period. ٠

*Children/students who have an existing health condition, should not answer YES, unless the symptom is new, different or getting worse.

- Has your child travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days? N
- Has your child been identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19? m.
- Has your child been instructed to stay home and self-isolate? 4

If "YES" to questions 2, 3 or 4:

Your child/student must stay home, self-isolate and follow the advice of public health.
