## Bike Safety Program -

**Extra Clothing** – We ask that you please send extra clothing with your children due to wet Spring conditions. Students (of all ages) often slip/fall during recess or outdoor activities and get muddy or wet and want a change of clothes. A Ziploc bag to be kept in their backpack would be appreciated.

**Volunteering in Schools and on Field Trips** - All parents, grandparents and community volunteers who wish to participate in any activity at the school, such as going on field trips, volunteering in the classroom, working in Breakfast Club or School Council Member will be required to have a police check completed and presented in its original format. We so encourage and value your participation that we would like to facilitate this as best we can. We can provide a cover letter to the local police detachment so that there is no cost to you. This process is good for three years once completed.

Safe Arrival/Dismissal - To ensure a safe environment for the students we ask that all parents and visitors come directly to the office and sign in. Students being picked up during the day must be signed out by an adult. REMINDER-the parking lot running along the school is one way only, running south. When dropping off or picking up a student, vehicles must stay in a single line – it is never safe to pass waiting vehicles. Parents can use the bus route to drop off students at the back gate in the morning if they follow in line with the busses. Students being picked up by car can be picked up at the front stairs at 3:40. Walkers are asked to walk through the school in the morning for safe entry onto the yard.
