Pediculosis (Head Lice)-Parents are asked to frequently check their child's head for pediculosis. Please notify the office to inform us of any findings of head lice. Spring and Fall are the seasons when head lice commonly infest school children.

School Safety-The safety of students and staff while attending school is of utmost concern. In response to this concern, our school maintains a fire safety plan, we have three practice fire drills in the Fall and Spring of each school year. We also practice lockdown and evacuation threat procedures annually.

Safe School Protocols-To ensure a safe environment for the students we ask that all parents and visitors come directly to the office and sign in. Parents are not to go to their child's class, we will bring them to the office. Student's being picked up during the day must be signed out by an adult.

Parents should never approach their child on the yard. If you need to see your child, please do so through the office.

There is no supervision on the yard prior to 9:00 so students should not enter the yard prior to this time.

Also, a friendly reminder that we are a "Nut Free" school. If you would like to send treats to share with the class please check with the classroom teacher ahead of sending them in.

We appreciate your support and cooperation in keeping our school safe for our students.

ORAL HEALTH SCHOOL SCREENING NOTIFICATION

Date of Screening: November 2nd & 3rd

Dental Screenings are being conducted at your child's school for:

- Students in Grades **JK, SK & 2.**
- Students in Grades **4 and 7** may also be screened.
- Any student as requested by the child/parent.

IMPORTANT:

- **Parents who do not wish to have their child screened are required to advise the school, in writing, each school year before the scheduled screening date.**
- **Selected students with urgent treatment needs may be rescreened at this time or at a later date.**

FYI:

- Oral health screening is a quick, visual oral assessment using a sterilized mouth mirror.
- The screening is a non-invasive oral assessment which can identify potential concerns.
- Oral health report cards are sent home with the children to inform parents of any dental concerns.
- The oral screening is conducted under the statutory authority of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.
- This screening should **NOT** replace your child's regular visit to the dentist.
