Vision Screening Notification

Date of Screening: April 28, 2019

Vision Screening is being conducted for Senior Kindergarten (SK) students at your child's school.

IMPORTANT:

 Parents who do not wish to have their child coreened are required to advice the school, in writing, before the scheduled coreening date. Include your child's name, date of birth, and the name of their school in the letter.

EWI:

- Vision screening takes children through three simple eye tests that can detect risk factors for certain vision disorders.
- It is non-invasive, so it is not harmful or painful in any way.
- Vision screening cannot diagnose vision disorders.
- Information about your child's vision screening is sent home to inform parents of lany vision concerns.
- The vision screening is conducted under the statutory authority of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.
- This screening should NOT replace your child's regular visit to the Optometrist for an eye examination.

Tooth Decay is Preventable!

April is National Oral Health Month. This April, Hastings Prince Edward Public Health (HPEPH) is reminding parents and caregivers that tooth decay is preventable! Small behaviours include brushing twice a day with a fluoridated toothpaste for two minutes each time, taking your child to a dental professional regularly, choosing snacks and drinks low in sugar which can help reduce your child's risk of tooth decay.



Profect Your Child's Smile with Fluoride Varnishi



Fluoride Varnish can help reduce tooth decay. Fluoride varnish is a protective coating that is painted onto the teeth. This coating makes teeth stronger to help prevent cavities from starting. The Fluoride Varnish program is available to all eligible children & youth up to the ages of 17 years in the Hastings and Prince Edward counties.
