Dry goods: Dole Fruit Cups – Fruit Salad or Diced Peaches (the kind that say "no sugar added"): we go through 5-10 packages a week, Quaker Oats Chewy Bars (Raspberry Crumble or Apple Crumble): we go through 5-10 packages a week, Blue Menu Steel Cut Oats (Maple and Brown Sugar): we go through about 1 package a week, Cheerios (Yellow box or Multigrain): we go through about 2-3 boxes a week, Sun-maid Raisins (big bag): we go through about 1-2 bags a week, Hunts Tomato Sauce (no salt added): we go through about 2-3 cans a month

Dairy: Tubs of Yoplait 0% Vanilla Yogurt: we go through about 2 tubs a week, Black Diamond or No name Cheese String (marble): we go through about 1 package a week, Shredded Cheese (Kraft Mild Cheddar made with 2% milk): we go through about 1 package a month, No name Cheese Slices (marble or medium): we go through about 3-4 packages a month, Yoplait or Danone Yogurt tubes: we go through about 3-4 cases a month

Miscellaneous: Ziploc Baggies (snack size/freezer), Reusable plastic plates, bowls, and cups, Food storage containers. Any donations would be appreciated.
