Advent is a time of year where we are often busy preparing all kinds of activities as a whole school community. Covid19 has forced us to be more creative in our planning again this year! We want our students to feel excited for the season so have come up with a few ways to do this safely and to still be able to give back to our community.

We will enjoy watching the recordings (one per day) through Microsoft Teams leading into the break. Unfortunately, we can't share the links with families as we have to honour privacy rights for media distribution. Christmas Fun on December 10th. Students will be decorating individual ceramic Christmas ornaments (from Crock A Doodle in Kingston). Once completed they will be sent out to be fired and returned to students to take home as a keepsake. Classes will connect through Teams to celebrate. Christmas music will be playing
