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DEFINITION OF ACADEMIC COURSE

In an academic course, a student learns the essential concepts of a subject and explores related material. Although knowledge and skills in the subject will be developed through both theory and practical applications, the emphasis will be on theory and abstract thinking as a basis for future learning and problem solving.

DEFINITION OF APPLIED COURSE

An applied course also covers the essential concepts of a subject. Knowledge and skill will be developed through theory and practical applications. In applied courses, familiar, real-life situations will be used to illustrate ideas, and more opportunities will be given to experience hands-on applications of the concepts studied.

DEFINITION OF OPEN COURSE

Open courses in Grades 9 and 10 are courses for all subjects other than those offered as academic and applied. They are designed to be appropriate for all students and provide students with a broad educational base that will prepare them for studies in Grades 11 and 12 and help prepare them for their roles in society.

DEFINITION OF LOCALLY DEVELOPED COURSE

These courses are designed only for students not ready to work at the applied level in Grade 9. Students will be recommended by Grade 8 teachers on consultation with parents & Special Education Department.
