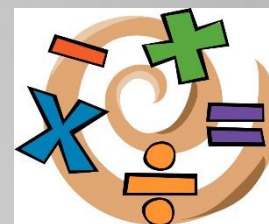

# Returning Grade 12 Course Selection Process

# Diploma Requirements:

Total of 30 credits for O.S.S.

- 18 ministry required courses
- A minimum of 12 additional credits to be selected from available courses (4 Religion credits are included)
- ▣ 4 credits in English
- ▣ 1 credit in French as a Second Language
- ▣ 3 credits in Mathematics (at least 1 credit in Gr. 11 or 12)
- ▣ 2 credits in Science
- ▣ 1 credit in Canadian History
- ▣ 1 credit in Canadian Geography
- ▣ 1 credit in the Arts (Music, Art, Drama)
- ▣ 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- ▣ 0.5 credit in Civics
- ▣ 0.5 credit in Career Studies



## Group 1:

- ▣ English/Third Language/French as a Second Language, or Native Language/ Social Science/Humanities/Canadian and World Studies/Guidance and Career Education/Cooperative Education

## Group 2:

- ▣ Health and Physical Education/ Business Studies/The Arts (Music, Art, Drama)/French as a Second Language/Cooperative Education

## Group 3:

- ▣ Gr. 11 or 12 Science/Technological Education (Grades 9-12)//French as a Second Language/Computer Science/Cooperative Education

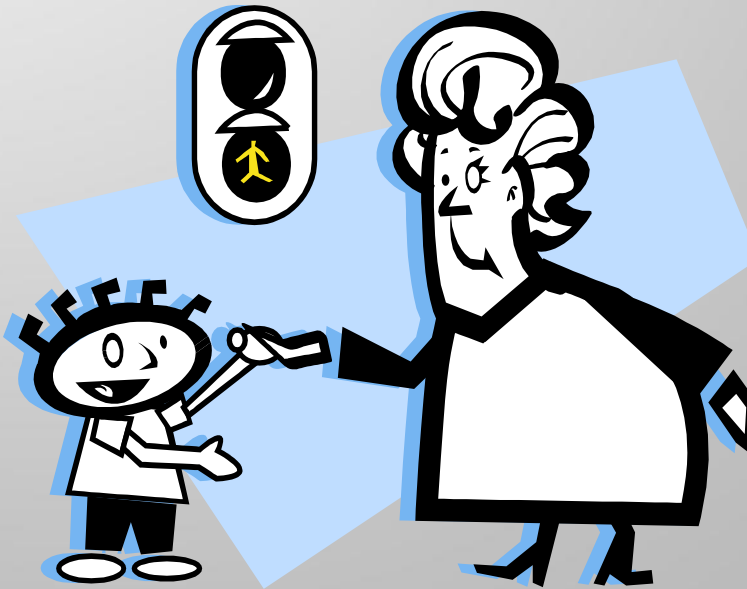

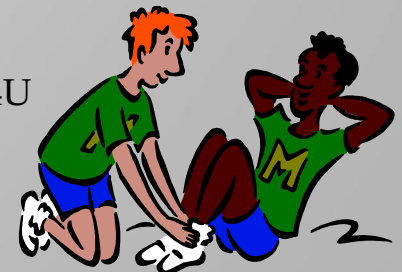
