

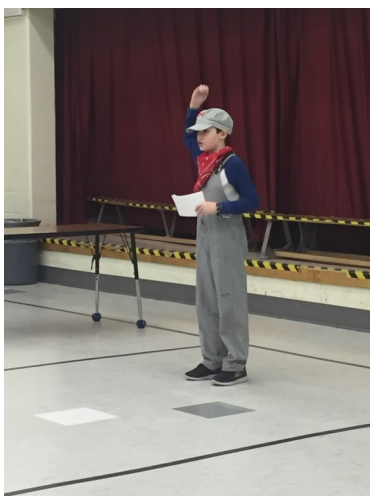
Our Lady of Fatima
