BLESSED PALMS NEEDED



We are approaching the season of Lent which begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6th. At that time, we have ashes placed on our foreheads in the sign of the cross as a symbol of the season and a reminder of the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross on Good Friday. These ashes are made by burning the blessed palms from Palm Sunday. Join the 21st Backyard Bird Count:



The Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC) is a joint partnership between Audubon and the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, with Bird Studies Canada as the official Canadian partner. This year marks the 21st Anniversary of the GBBC and it will occur this year between February 16th to February 19th (Family Day Weekend). The GBBC engages birdwatchers of all ages across North America in counting birds to create a real-time snapshot of where the birds are. Anyone can participate, from beginners to experts. You can count for as little as 15 minutes on a single day, or for as long as you like each day of the event. It's free, fun, and easy and it helps the birds!
