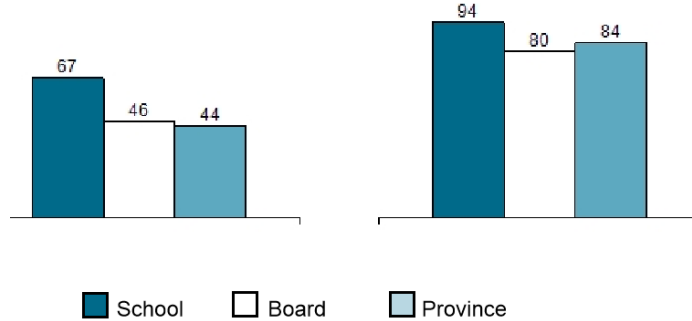

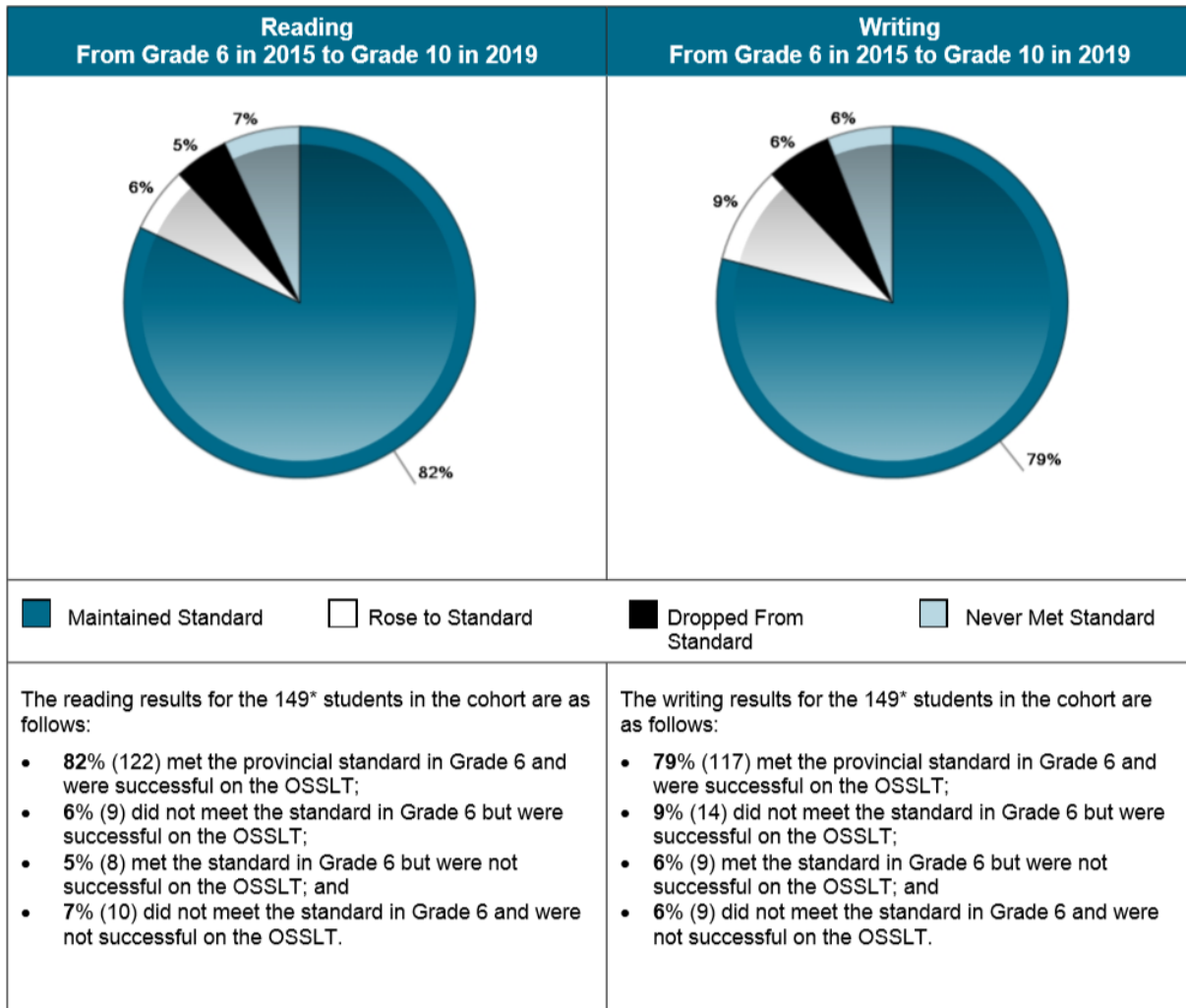
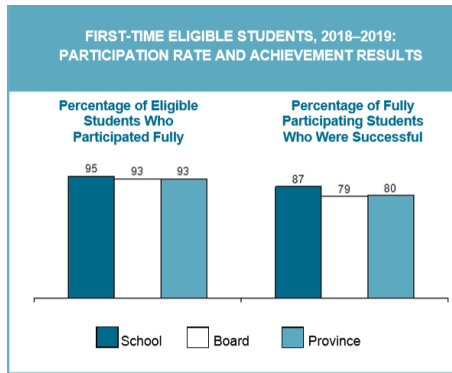

<p>The mathematics results for the 53* students in the applied course in the cohort are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21% (11) met the provincial standard in Grade 6 and Grade 9; • 45% (24) did not meet the standard in Grade 6 but met it in Grade 9; • 4% (2) met the standard in Grade 6 but did not meet it in Grade 9; and • 30% (16) did not meet the standard in Grade 6 and did not in Grade 9. 	<p>The mathematics results for the 125* students in the academic course in the cohort are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 71% (89) met the provincial standard in Grade 6 and Grade 9; • 22% (27) did not meet the standard in Grade 6 but met it in Grade 9; • 3% (4) met the standard in Grade 6 but did not meet it in Grade 9; and • 4% (5) did not meet the standard in Grade 6 and did not in Grade 9.
