Student Participation Agreement

The following conditions apply to all students in the International Education Program.

The student agrees to

1. respect and obey the laws of Canada.
2. respect and obey the rules of the school where they attend, the Principal, Vice-principal, Teachers and Staff.
3. attend school on a regular basis. Any absences must be explained by a note to the school from the homestay parent.
4. accept his/her responsibility as a student. This includes making a determined effort to succeed in his/her school work, and completing all homework and assignments on time.
5. maintain at least a 60% average and have good work habits in order to be allowed to continue in the program.
6. reside in a homestay that is approved and arranged by the Supervisor of International.
7. respect and obey his/her guardian, and the homestay parent(s)
8. respect the members of the homestay family and act as a member of the family. The student will obey family rules and voluntarily assist with regular household chores. The student will not talk about the homestay family's private affairs to others.
9. inform homestay parent(s) if they will be home late, not coming home for dinner, or leaving the home for a social visit, and inform the homestay parent(s) of their destination, time of return and obtain the homestay(s) prior consent.
10. share school work, report cards and other correspondence from the school with the homestay parent(s).
11. to pay for all expenses incurred including but not limited to any losses or damages caused by the student.
12. to obtain the homestay approval prior to making any long-distance calls.
13. to reimburse the board its fees and expenses related to any breach of this agreement, including without limitation, legal fees and related costs.

The student is NOT permitted to

14. visit establishments such as pornographic shops, adult theaters, bars and night clubs.
15. drive or own any motorized vehicle.
16. abuse the use of the Internet by visiting pornographic or violent sites.
17. to invite a person of the opposite sex into their bedroom to visit, study or stay overnight.
18. smoke if they are under 19 years of age. By Ontario law, persons under 19 years of age are not permitted to purchase or smoke cigarettes. Smoking is not permitted on school property or public buildings or their homestay's home.
19. purchase or drink alcohol.
20. purchase or use drugs or medication unless prescribed by a doctor.
21. change homestay families or schools without approval. Any changes in a homestay must be done through the Supervisor of International. One month's notice must be given or the homestay paid one month's fee in lieu of notice prior to any move. A \$200.00 administrative fee may also apply.
22. to go on trips without adequate supervision if they are less than 18 years of age.

The student is permitted to

23. take a trip with the homestay family or with an adult (25 years or older) providing permission from the natural parent(s) is provided in advance. If a student is going on a trip with an adult, the Supervisor of International and the homestay parent(s) must be informed in writing, of the destination, length of the trip, the adult supervisor's name and contact information.

Any on-going failure to abide by the above guidelines and rules may result in dismissal from the International Student Program. The cost of returning home will be at the student's parent's expense and notification will be sent to Citizenship and Immigration Canada. No refund of tuition fees will be issued.
