Student Involvement in Social Issues Activities

Where such issues have system-wide implications for Catholic education, the Board expects the participation of pupils to be managed with particular discretion and sensitivity.

POLICY MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

Student Involvement in Social Issues Activities

- 1. All requests for the participation of students in activities meant to highlight social issues must be made to the principal(s) of the local school(s).
- 2. Parental consent for students under 18 years of age must be obtained whenever such participation is remote from the school (as per Policy 1999-11-2 School Excursions) and the denial of that consent will oblige the school to accommodate the student in reasonable alternative activities.
- 3. The principal will advise the appropriate Superintendent of Education of such involvement of students at least two weeks before the date of the event.
- 4. Where the issue may have system-wide implications for Catholic education, the issue will be brought to the attention of the Board with a recommendation for participation as necessary from the Director of Education.
- 5. The above timeline notwithstanding, when an immediate issue arises regarding student participation in social issues activities, the Director will respond and communicate his decision to the Chair of the Board.

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
