Class Restructuring-After much discussion with senior administration of our Board it became necessary to do some restructuring of the classes which take effect the week of November 2nd. As you are aware, due to COVID-19, ALCDSB has created a Remote Learning School. Recently, families were given the choice to move between Remote Learning and In-Person Learning, creating change in our student enrollment. Based on this change to student enrollment, changes to the Board budget and the province-wide teacher shortage, ALCDSB had to make the decision to re-organize teachers within some of our Catholic schools. We continue to work with our local public health units to ensure that these transitions are safe for our students and staff. We wish to congratulate Mrs. Campbell who has secured a contract position with St. Mary's in Trenton. We would like to thank her for all that she has done with our students.
