I ask that everyone take a moment over these holidays to reflect on a quote from Pope Francis:



For those interested in attending an open house and information session at NHHS, there will be one on **February 6th** at 6:30pm.


#### MADAWASKA VALLEY DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL

#### FRIGID COLD TEMPERATURES



The guidelines most schools follow are based on the Canadian Paediatrics Society states that students can be outdoors in temperatures as low as -25C air, -28C wind chill.

That being said, if we truly feel that temperatures other than the ones listed above pose a potential risk to the well-being of students, indoor recess can be chosen.

Students are expected to dress warmly and cannot be coming in unsupervised as a means of "warming up" if they're choosing (within reason) to not dress appropriately for the weather conditions.

Please ensure your children dress according to the weather conditions.
