

Updated Guidance on COVID Testing and Isolation



Our direction on monitoring and managing COVID like symptoms comes from the Renfrew County District Health Unit.

Update: If there is someone symptomatic in your home they must self-isolate and get tested. They can return to school or work when they receive negative test results. Household members must self-monitor for any symptoms but do not need testing if they do not have symptoms. Household members that are symptom-free can continue to attend school or work with careful attention to physical distancing, masking and handwashing rules.

Little Caesars Fundraising






Outdoor Learning


