### PEDICULOSIS (HEAD LICE) CONTROL:

Spring and fall are the seasons when **HEAD LICE** commonly infest school children. Head lice feed on blood and cement their eggs, commonly called nits, to strands of hair at the scalp. The nits take

approximately 7-10 days to hatch. The bite of a louse causes itching which can be aggravated and infected by scratching. Please check your child's head on a regular basis. If you find evidence of head lice or nits, information about how to remove them is available from your family doctor, health unit and most pharmacies. Our trained volunteers will be conducting pediculosis checks periodically throughout the school year.
