## WATER SUSTAINABILITY OUTDOOR EDUCATION DAY




On September 26th, the Grade 7/8 students travelled to the H.R. Frink Centre for a full day learning experience about water sustainability and stewardship. With the support of Quinte Conservation, students had the opportunity to reflect on water run-off and treatment, and to conduct water testing scenarios. We found bioindicators (Bugs!) and tested for pH levels in the Moira waterways. Students also participated in interactive activities highlighting the need for clean drinking water in our global community.
