Saint Valentine (patron saint of happy marriages, love) Feast day: February 14 Known for the popular holiday St. Valentine's Day, the real Saint Valentine is the patron saint of happy marriages, love, and young people. Despite the holiday, Saint Valentine was actually a martyred priest who was beheaded in Rome on February 14th in Rome. Very little is known about Saint Valentine and it is believed that the traditions of Valentine's Day developed in England inspired by the work of Geoffrey Chaucer. In 1969, the feast of Saint Valentine was removed from the Roman Catholic Calendar of Saints because so little is known about his life and with the common practices associated with the holiday today.
