Student Pick-up, Drop-off, and Parking

Just a reminder, please be very careful as you navigate the parking lot or when you are pulling on and off the road.

1)Pick-up

If you are picking up your child before 3:35pm dismissal, parents will ring the bell attached to the safety camera and we will call your child/children down to meet you at the door and will take care of the sign out. Please wait at the door.

2)Morning Drop-off
