## **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATIONS**

St. Patrick Catholic School is now accepting registrations for Junior and Senior Kindergarten (as well as all other grades) for next year. If your child is already attending J.K. at St. Patrick's, you do not need to register them again for S.K. Junior Kindergarten Eligibility: 4 years of age on or before December 31, 2022. Both Junior and Senior Kindergarten are offered on the full day basis. Requirements for registration are a Catholic Baptismal Certificate, Birth Certificate or Birth Registration, and Immunization Records. All registrations must be completed using the online link on our school website.

#### **Lenten Activities**

As an Easter tradition, our school was led by our Gr. 5 and 6 students in The Stations of the Cross on Thursday, April 14th. As always, it is a meaningful time where students are able to retell and consider the events around Jesus' crucifixion, which is a cornerstone of our faith.
