- all round robin games will be two 12 minute halves with a 2 minute half time break.
- last minute of game is stop time if difference is less than or equal to eight points.
- 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie.
- teams finishing in 1st and 2nd in their division will play a semi final game.
- two minute warm up between games.
- tournament to be held at Queen's Faculty of Education Gym.
- for junior tournaments, only man-to-man defence is permitted in the defensive zone.
- offensive zone presses will be permitted as well as double teaming but not in the defensive zone in junior tournaments.

*All junior tournaments will eliminate foul shots to increase playing time. Instead, the team that gets fouled on while shooting **will receive one point, and will gain possession**. If a player is fouled and completes a successful basket, then that will be a three point play but the scoring team **will not gain** possession. Non shooting fouls will be loss of possession as usual.*
