ONTARIO YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM - "NEXT STEPS"

- 1. Before the end of your placement, ask your employer if there are any skills in your Training Standard (Log book) that can be signed off
- 2. If you are interested in continuing to work for this employer, have the conversation with them to see if they can keep you on as a *registered apprentice*
- 3. Notify the Ministry of what your next steps are (See option 1,2,3, or 4 below)
- 4. Regardless of what your next steps are, you need to submit a copy of your Copy of OSSD (Ontario Secondary School Diploma) or OST (Ontario Student Transcript) both are provided to you by your High School

OPTION 1

If you are **continuing in the trade with your current employer**, you need to notify your local Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD) office by submitting this form (see next page)
