What is SHSM?

SHSM programs allow students to customize their high school experience and better prepare for graduation and beyond. This career-focused program is designed to bundle courses, related workplace experience, and certifications and training. Every SHSM program includes the following components:

- 4 credits in grade 11 and 12 courses that provide sectorspecific knowledge and skills
- 2 credits in Cooperative Education related to the sector
- 1 credit in another grade 11 or 12 subject related to the sector;
- 6 or 7 sector-recognized certifications or training courses/programs, such as First Aid, CPR and WHMIS;
- Experiential learning and career exploration activities within the sector;
- Reach ahead experiences connected with students' postsecondary pathways;
- Sector-partnered experiences, such as Innovation, Creativity and Entrepreneurship (ICE) training or mathematical literacy or coding activities.
