# What is an Autism Skills Group?

The After School ABA Program is offering <u>free</u> Autism Skills Groups to children/youth diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. The groups will focus on teaching a variety of skills including social, behaviour/emotional regulation, daily living and communication.

# What are some skills my child/youth might learn in a group?

• Problem solving

• Accepting "no"

Greeting others

• Identifying feelings

Asking friends to play

• Meal preparation

# Who can join?

Students diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder, aged 3 to 21, of the Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School

Groups will be developed based on age, location and skill. Parents may be asked to participate in weekly parent information sessions.

### When and where?

The groups will occur weekly and run for 6 weeks. All groups will be scheduled after regular school hours. The program will be offered at various schools across the Belleville and Quinte West regions.
