PEERS® is an evidence-based social skills intervention for socially motivated teens with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) in grades 7-12 who are interested in learning skills to help them make and keep friends. Applications are due by Friday January 21, 2022.

Students will learn how to:

- use appropriate conversational skills
- appropriately use humour
- enter and exit conversations between peers
- handle rejection, teasing, and bullying
- handle rumours and gossip
- make phone calls to friends
- choose appropriate friends
- handle arguments and disagreements
- change a bad reputation
