PROGRAMME FEES

The cost for the full Diploma Programme is \$300.00 per year for each year of high school (Grades 9-12). The cost of IB Diploma Courses is \$300.00 for the first course and \$250.00 for each additional course. These fees are non-refundable and subject to change.

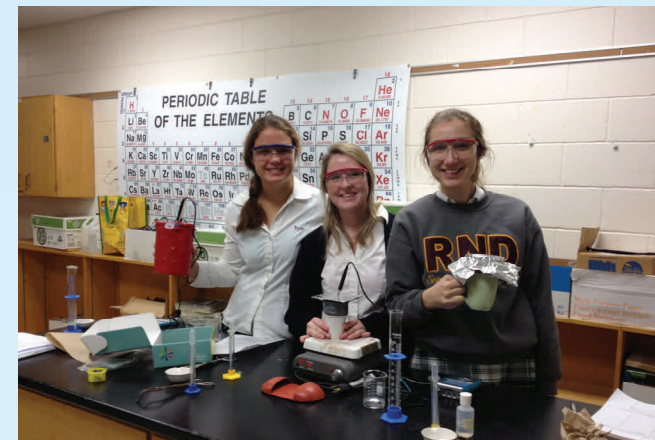

The IB Diploma Programme:

- * is an **INTERNATIONALLY** recognized curriculum

ADMISSION

To qualify for admission into the Grade 9 Preparatory Year, students require the recommendation of their Grade 8 teacher and must maintain achievement at the provincial standard in all academic courses

THE DIPLOMA

The **Grades 11 and 12** curriculum consists of six subject groups:

- * Studies in Language and Literature
- * Language Acquisition
- * Individuals and Societies
- * Experimental Sciences
- * Mathematics
- * Arts and Electives

In addition, all diploma candidates must complete:

- * Theory of Knowledge course
- * 150 hours of Creative, Action and Service Activities
- 4,000 word research based Extended Essay

IB DIPLOMA COURSES

- As an alternative to the full Diploma, students may take individual IB subjects as well as Theory of Knowledge, the Creativity, Action, Service and/or the Extended Essay as IB Diploma Courses



WHY THE IB PROGRAMME?

1. The programme offers unparalleled preparation for university.
2. The programme encourages students to think globally, and the curriculum is based on international standards.
3. IB classes are completed alongside peers with common abilities and ambitions.
4. Universities award first year credits for some IB Diploma Courses.
