Ash Wednesday is celebrated on the Wednesday 46 days before Easter and the day after Mardi Gras or Shrove Tuesday. Ash Wednesday marks the first day of Lent and the starting of approximately 6 weeks of fasting and penance. Ash Wednesday is a day of prayer and fasting.

This year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 which is also Valentine's Day. In order to preserve the solemn mood of the day, all Valentine's Day activities, including exchanges of cards and treats, will be held on Tuesday, February 13.
