#### ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL LITERACY TEST (OSSLT)

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test has been scheduled by the Ministry of Education for Wednesday and Thursday October 23rd and 24th. All students who were enrolled in Grade 9 in September 2001 must write the test. Holy Cross will be conducting the test between 8:30 and 11:15 a.m. both days. Parents must reschedule appointments during this time. Students late to the test will jeopardize their completion of the tasks. There is no extra time all otted for these circumstances.

Weekly practice sessions for various components of the test have been conducted with students during classes. Students were given a pamphlet produced by the Ministry of Education describing the types of questions, tips for reading and writing, and sample instructions for the Test. You may view the sample test materials and related resource materials on the Education Quality and Accountability Office website at www.egao.com.

Test questions are designed to assess skills that will be important to students in their studies and in other life circumstances. The writing tasks focus on communicating information and opinions in clearly written paragraphs. Parent/guardians will be advised in writing of their son/daughter's test outcome. Those students who have not been successful may retake the test in a session to be held October 2003.

Accommodations will be made for students who have an individual education plan.
