What are Dual Credits?

Students participate in post-secondary courses, earning dual credits that count towards both their high school diploma (OSSD) and their post-secondary diploma or apprenticeship certification.

Benefits of Dual Credits:

- · Assist in the completion of your OSSD
- Help you explore college programs and career options
- · Ease your transition from secondary school to college
- · Give you a head start on your future post-secondary path

Who Can Take a Dual Credit?

Grade 11, 12 or 5th year students who:

- Are unsure of a pathway beyond secondary school
- Would benefit from a college or apprenticeship experience
- May need learning opportunities outside of the high school setting

Students can earn up to four Dual Credits with no cost!
