

# My Student Did Not Pass COVID-19 Screening

Students with stable symptoms of a known chronic medical condition may attend school. If there are concerns, consult your health care provider and follow their guidance.

Call the school and inform them of your student's illness and absence.

**Your student must not attend school AND**

- **Should be tested for COVID-19** and isolate until a negative test result is received. Your student, with a negative test, can return to school if **all of the following apply**:
  - The student does not have a fever (without using medication).
  - It has been at least 24 hours since the student's symptoms started improving.
  - If you have questions, your health care provider, with knowledge of your student's medical and underlying

conditions, can help determine if your symptomatic student needs to be tested for COVID-19.

- **If not tested for COVID-19** your student and all household members must remain home on isolation for 14 days from the onset of symptoms, unless **all of the following apply**:
  - A doctor diagnosed the student with another illness.
  - The student does not have a fever (without using medication).
  - It has been at least 24 hours since the student's symptoms started improving.

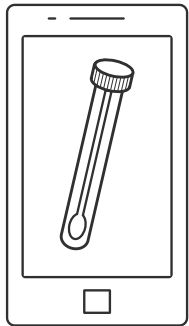
## Please note:

KFL&A Public Health is unable to provide clinical assessment or determine the suitability of a student returning to school. If the ill student is tested, household members (family and roommates who live with the ill person) should monitor for symptoms and be tested if symptoms develop. They are not required to isolate at this time.

Stay home



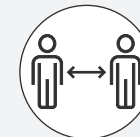
Wash hands frequently
