Robotics Club



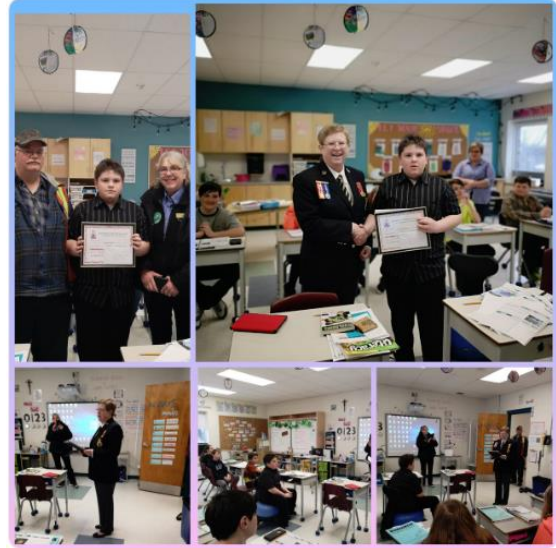
St. Martin of Tours students have been working on robots with WPS and are preparing for the upcoming competition. Permission forms being sent home with those students who have been interested in Robotics Club.
