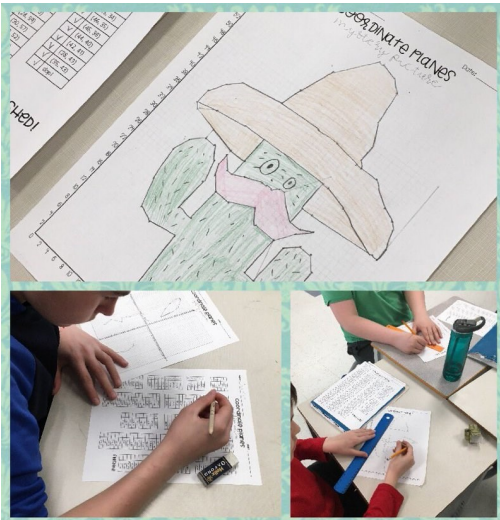
## TOWER GARDEN UPDATE
