Our Annual End of Year Picnic will be held on **Wednesday, JUNE 26<sup>th</sup>** at the Lester B. Smith building.

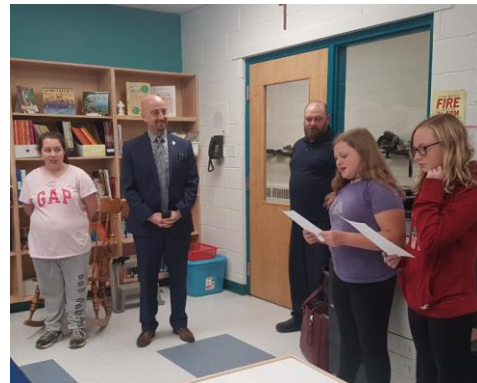
### Canada's Wonderland School Trip
