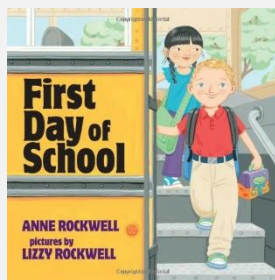


SUMMER – ENJOY!!!

Once again I encourage you to sign up for School Cash Online. No student should be bringing cash to school. You do not have to purchase anything to create an account.
