#### EQUITY AND INCLUSION – ACCESS TO INTERNET FOR OUR STUDENTS AND FAMILIES



As part of Algonquin and Lakeshore's work on Equity Education, each school in the Board was asked to look at equity issues within our schools and to come up with an inquiry question pertinent to our communities.

Here at Our Lady of Mercy we chosen to look at the equity issues around Internet access, speed and its use. Mr. Tod developed a survey using Office 365's Forms so we could gather information from our Grade 3 to 8 students about: 1) if they had Internet at home; 2) if the students had devices on which they could do their school/home work; 3) if their Internet speed was sufficient to do their school/home work; 4) what did the students used the Internet for; and 5) if there were any rules in their households around the access and/or use of the Internet.

The responses were very interesting and we think we have a better idea around the equity issue we chose to address. However, we would now like our parent community to complete a very similar survey to what your children completed. We would like to see how reliable the data is that we have gathered.

Additionally, we are considering offering an evening in the Fall of 2018 centred around sharing of best practices around Internet use and access as well as other issues that you, the parent community, identify as areas of need for you and your children. The last two questions in the survey are centred around gathering information about what you see as things you would like more information about and/or ideas for the evening.

We ask that you complete the survey by **Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>** so we can collate responses and write the grant proposal that could provide funding for the evening that we are planning for this Fall.
