- Note: **Specific prerequisites may change and vary from one College to another and from year to year — Check College Website for most up-to-date information.



Other Important Information

- Repeated courses do not count as two credits
- Most Colleges do NOT give extra credit for taking courses at the "U" level
- College diplomas often receive credit for University transfer. Be sure to contact the college and university directly. Do NOT make assumptions about transfers.
- If you have an IEP, you must self-identify. It does not automatically transfer to College.

Application Process

- All applications will be done on-line
- Students access the application at www.ontariocolleges.ca
- The fee is \$95 for up to 5 choices (3 at any one College) – paid by Credit Card
- Applications MUST be completed by Christmas break

Highly Competitive Programs

These are programs that have more applicants than spots available. It is important to apply EARLY!

Depending on the program, colleges may require specific secondary school subjects as prerequisites, and they may set minimum grade cut-offs in these subjects. Some programs may also require a portfolio, essay, or other supporting documentation. Pay attention to DEADLINES!

- An advanced diploma 3 year program
- **Certificate programs** 1year program

- **Graduate certificates** needs a diploma or degree
- Collaborative programs both college and university
- Apprenticeship programs
