HOT LUNCH 2023/2024

Dear parents/guardians,

It is time to get the Hot Lunch and Milk Program up and running. This year, we will be continuing online ordering to ensure accuracy and to make the process as easy for everyone as possible. **Hot lunch orders will only be through SchoolCash Online, which is the same program in which parents/guardians are able to pay for items such as field trips, milk cards, agendas, etc.** The link to School Cash Online can be found on our school website or by clicking <https://alcdsb.schoolcashionline.com/>.

The first hot lunch day will be Tuesday, October 3. Our first day for milk delivery will be Tuesday, October 10. Please note that hot lunch days will take place on Tuesdays again this year while milk is available every day.

***All hot lunch items remain available online to order until the week prior to that hot lunch event. Note all hot lunch days are accessible and you can order all at once, in batches, or individually, keeping in mind that items close the Tuesday prior. Unfortunately, we cannot accept any late orders, as time is required to process the reports and allow the vendor time to prepare the orders. Milk is ongoing and can be ordered anytime.**

Depending on the week, students are able to order from one of the food providers above and we will rotate through each of the 3 restaurant options from week to week. You will be able to see which options are available each week when you order online.
