### 1. A bundle of Grade 11 and Grade 12 credits

#### Major Credits

Four Grade 11 and 12 credits that build a foundation of sector-focused knowledge and skills before entering a postsecondary destination; at least one of the credits must be Grade 12. An extra co-op credit (beyond the two credits required below) may count for one of these major credits.

Since the required Grade 11 World Religions course counts as one major credit, only three more are needed.

#### Other Required Credits with CLAs

**2. Certifications and/or training courses/programs**

Six industry-recognized certifications that provide knowledge and skills related to safe work habits and sector-specific training and give students an advantage when entering the workforce. For instance, Standard First Aid, CPR Level C (including AED), customer service, and WHMIS generic instruction are compulsory certifications for Hospitality and Tourism.

**3. Experiential learning and career exploration**

Activities that take place outside the traditional classroom setting and allow students to observe, participate in, and reflect on a variety of sector-specific experiences and careers. Examples include job shadowing, job twinning, worksite tours, and attendance at career fairs, conferences or competitions hosted by the sector.

**4. Reach ahead experiences**

Experiences connected with students' postsecondary plans that provide them with an opportunity to experience the next step in their chosen pathway. Examples include tours of colleges, universities, training facilities and workplaces, interviews of employees in the sector or students studying in the field, and dual credit courses.


**5. Ontario Skills Passport**

The development and demonstration of Essential Skills and work habits required in the sector, assessed and recorded using the tools in the Ontario Skills Passport (OSP), that allow students to learn about occupation-related tasks and careers in the field. The OSP will be completed during the sector-related coop placement.
