- 3. students must be willing to forego a full year of academic credits during their year of exchange none of your courses during your exchange year count as credits in Canada
- 4. families of outbound students must be willing to host an INBOUND student for a minimum of 3 months no exceptions as we need greater participation from families of OUTBOUND students

Please bring a copy of your completed Preliminary Outbound Student Application (attached). There are a lot of resources on the internet regarding the Rotary Youth Exchange program. We encourage you to look into its rich history, and the growth of the exchange – especially in our own district 7070.

Once students have learned more about the program, we'll then ask for interviews with parents and candidates to be held on November 29<sup>th</sup> (same location, times to be determined based upon number of candidates). A decision will be made re: the successful OUTBOUND student before the year end 2017.
